The following is a listing of each band member's equipment requirements. When a buyer is providing "back line" equipment it would be convenient for the band members to be provided with the same equipment that they are used to performing with. Michael Furlong-guitar rig/center stage: Line 6 POD HD500 provided by artist, power to center stage, 2 XLR cables for onboard direct outs, 2 vocal monitors, 1 guitar stand.

Steve Hatley-keys rig/stage right: 2 Tier Ultimate Support keyboard stand or two on stage keyboard stands with configuration for two keyboards, 2 Roland KC550 keyboard amps, 1 Yamaha Motif 7 Keyboard, 1 Korg CX3 keyboard, 1 piano bench of a brand name, or a drum throne, which can get from 26" to 28" in height., 1 vocal monitor.

Wesley Orsolic-lead guitar rig/stage right: Vox Custom Classic AC30 or Fender Twin Reverb guitar amp, 1 vocal monitor, 1 guitar stand.

Larry Hart-bass guitar rig/stage left to drum kit: SWR-400 bass guitar amp, 2-SWR 410 speaker cabinets, 1 vocal monitor, 1 guitar stand.

Glenn Hicks-drums: 4 piece DW or Yamaha Recording series drum kit, kick, snare, rack tom, floor tom, high-hat, crash and ride cymbals.

5-monitor mixes, 6 monitors, 5 vocal mics with boom stands SPX-90 effects processing for stage monitors.
